

Continued from the other side

If the Holy Spirit reminds you that there is a **breech in relationship** with a brother or sister in Christ, repent of any wrong doing that you are responsible for today. And then try to make it right as soon as possible. Jesus said that how we treat our brothers and sisters is an indication of how we treat Him. Unresolved conflict must not be allowed to fester.

Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself. That is why many of you are weak and ill, and some have died. But if we judged ourselves truly, we would not be judged. But when we are judged by the Lord, we are disciplined so that we may not be condemned along with the world.

- 1 Corinthians 11:27-32 (ESV)

Other times we invite people to come to the four corners of the room, to tables with the elements on them. If you are unable for physical reasons to move to the tables, please consider asking a friend or an usher to help you by bringing the elements to you.

Believing children may participate, at the discretion of their parents. Some parents have chosen to have their children wait to participate until they have gone through public identification with Christ through water baptism. In this way the child is reminded monthly of their need to be obedient to Jesus' command to be baptized.

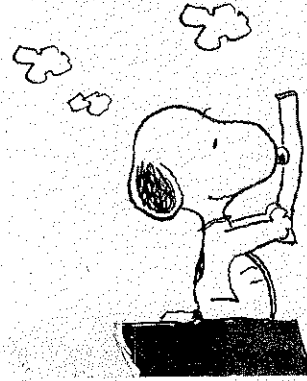

Communion (The Lord's Table) at Trinity Fellowship

Later in today's service of worship you will be invited to participate in Communion (The Lord's Table). The following thoughts can help you understand and prepare for this special act of worship.

All believers are invited to participate. You do not need to be a member of Trinity, just a committed follower of Jesus Christ. Remember, taking part does not “earn” you good favor in God's sight. Rather, it is a way to remember with gratitude and anticipation what the Son of God has done for us. By joining in we proclaim the Lord's death (the work He did on the cross that paid the penalty for our sin and made it possible for us to be forgiven). And we do so “until He comes again” (looking forward to the second coming of the Savior when He makes all things right under His reign as King).

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, “This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.” For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

- 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (ESV)

As a believer, **we encourage you to examine yourself.** Ask the Holy Spirit to show you if you have any unconfessed sin in your life. If He reveals anything to you, confess it today. That means to agree with God that it was wrong and to turn away from it in repentance. If the Spirit does not reveal anything, or after you have confessed what He has revealed, partake with joy (knowing that you are forgiven through the work of Jesus on the cross).
